FAQs - STUDENTS

Q. Do students work on the Upstart Challenge individually or as part of a team?

A. Whilst ideas often start with one person, it's important to learn that no one person has all the skills and attributes required to successfully create a worthy solution, be it commercially or community driven. Therefore, students must come together to work in teams to participate in the Upstart Challenge

Q. How many students can be in a team?

A. It is up to you/your teacher, but we recommend teams are made up of 2-4 students.

Q: How can I participate in the Upstart Challenge?

A: The Upstart Challenge is open to all schools/youth organisations in Australia so if your school/youth organisation hasn't already signed up, let them know you'd love to take part! Your teacher/youth leader can enroll for the program at www.upstarthq.com.au/upstart-challenge.

Q. Is there a cost for students/parents?

A. No, there is no cost for students or parents. Schools pay a small fee for their class to participate and access the program materials. Students complete the challenge under the guidance of their teacher.

Q. Will I get feedback on my pitch?

A. Up to 3 team pitches per registered class can be submitted to the Upstart team for review and feedback via the Upstart learning portal.
